NEWS THIS WEEK

IN YOUR PRAYERS please remember those members of our parish community who are sick, and those who care for them. We also remember in prayer those who have died, those who grieve, and those whose anniversaries occur.

GOING FORWARDS We now have the new guidelines from the Catholic Bishops which, beginning from 19th July, envisage a slow return to more normal parish life and worship; with the idea that we work towards the First Sunday of Advent in fully reclaiming Sunday as the day we gather together for Mass in Church. Obviously there is a lot of water that can go under the bridge before then. There are some things we know, i.e. for the time being we will still be wearing masks and sanitising our hands as we enter and leave the church. At the moment, there is no return to filling the holy water stoups. We can, slowly, begin to reintroduce some congregational singing. However, ceasing social distancing at Mass appears to be a decision based on local conditions (size of church, etc.) and this has to take account of how safe people feel. Before thinking of making any change in that regard I want the chance to discuss things with the Parish Pastoral Council. So there will be no change on this at Our Lady's until I have had the opportunity to have this conversation, and equally no change affecting St. Joseph's Green Hammerton either. If you want to express an opinion please let me know.

FORTHCOMING FUNERAL The Requiem Mass for Geoff Holland will be at 12.15pm on 20th July. As Geoff was well known there is a booking form open so that parishioners can use places not needed by the family.
