SUDAN APPEAL CAFOD have been in touch. The war in Sudan has forced millions of families to leave their homes. Some 25 million people, about half of the population are in need of immediate assistance and 8 million are at risk of famine by June 2024. CAFOD have asked, given this humanitarian emergency, that we hold an extraordinary collection. This will take place on 26th May, Trinity Sunday. FORTHCOMING WORKS Work is urgently needed on the gutters and downpipes from the main church roof and from the flat roofs either side as well as the boards at either end of the church roof. We have damp coming in through the walls affecting the area (Cornlands Road side) which was recently decorated. The downpipes are no longer sufficient to deal with the quantity of rain we get during flash summer storms and this will only get worse. As this essential work will require scaffolding this may be the moment to explore the possibility of solar panels which would provide electricity for the church, Fr. Kelly Room, Parish House and Parish Hall. We are in conversation with the Diocese on both of these.

PLEASE BE KIND It would be a great help if people could take responsibility to return hymn books, newsletters (unless you are taking them home) and Mass prayer cards, after Mass is over, to the place where you picked them up. If anyone would like to take on the responsibility of keeping these things tidy, so that the church is a welcoming place to come into, it would be most welcome.

MORE VOLUNTEERS STILL NEEDED to facilitate tea/coffee after Sunday Mass. Obviously the more teams the less often it is your turn. Sunday morning coffee is an important part of parish life but it will need more volunteers if it is going to continue. Please get in touch.
